
- a. The certificate holder is authorized to perform line maintenance for certificate holders conducting operations under 14 CFR Parts 121, 135, and for foreign air carriers or foreign persons operating a U.S.-registered aircraft in common carriage under 14 CFR Part 129. Line maintenance may be performed for the listed air carriers at the following location(s) listed in Table 1, provided it has the facilities, equipment, trained personnel, and technical data to perform such line maintenance. Under the terms and conditions of a BASA/MIP the FAA will only recognize the line stations located within the country where the repair station is domiciled.

- b. This line maintenance authorization only applies if the certificate holder performs maintenance functions for operators conducting operations under 14 CFR Parts 121, 135, and for foreign air carriers or foreign persons operating a U.S.-registered aircraft in common carriage under 14 CFR Part 129.
- c. This line maintenance authorization alone does not constitute a rating.
- (1) The certificate holder must have a limited rating or class rating to perform inspections and minor maintenance associated with a line maintenance authorization.
  - (2) A repair station that is issued a limited rating to perform line maintenance only must state in the limitations cell of paragraph A003 the scope of work to be performed.
  - (3) This paragraph must be issued to a repair station whose only function is to perform line maintenance and to repair stations issued paragraph D100 that perform line maintenance on a continuous basis away from their fixed base.
- d. The certificate holder must perform line maintenance in accordance with the operator's manual and approved maintenance program of the Part 121, 135, or 129 operator for which the work is being conducted.
- e. This line maintenance authorization does not constitute a geographic authorization.
- f. The certificate holder may perform continuous operations at the facilities listed in Table 1 above.
- g. Privileges of a line station, as set forth by any EASA line station rating, are authorized at the locations listed in Table 1, as applicable.


